
SCP Awards – TERMS OF REFERENCE

SCP AWARD OF MERIT

The SCP Award of Merit may be presented to recognize any person, who is not a member of the College, who through their active participation has promoted the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists and/or the profession of Pharmacy in Saskatchewan.

1. The nominee must have contributed to the active promotion of the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists or to the profession of Pharmacy either on a local, provincial or national level.
2. Any person, who is not a member of the College, may be nominated for the SCP Award of Merit.
3. Nomination papers must be accompanied by a summary of the qualifications of the nominee consistent with the Terms of Reference.
4. Nominations must be received in the office of the Registrar by January 31st.
5. The selection will be approved by Council (SCP) following recommendation from the Awards and Honours Committee.
6. When possible, the SCP Award of Merit will be presented in conjunction with the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists Annual General Meeting.
7. Recipients will receive a suitably framed certificate signed by the President and the Registrar.
8. The SCP Award of Merit does not necessarily have to be presented in any given year.

SCP CERTIFICATE OF RECOGNITION

The SCP Certificate of Recognition will be presented to the retiring Presidents, Councillors, and committee members of the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists for their dedication and contributions to the Council of the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists.

1. The nominee must have made a special contribution to the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists either on a local, provincial or national level.
2. The nominee(s) must be a member in good standing of the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists.
3. Nomination papers must be accompanied by a summary of the qualifications of the nominee consistent with the Terms of Reference.
4. Nominations must be received in the office of the Registrar by January 31st.

5. The selection will be approved by Council (SCP) following recommendation from the Awards and Honours Committee.
6. When possible, the Certificate of Recognition will be presented in conjunction with the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists Annual General Meeting.
7. Recipients will receive a suitable Certificate of Recognition signed by the President and the Registrar.
8. A Certificate of Recognition does not necessarily have to be presented in any given year.

HONORARY LIFE MEMBER AWARD

An Honorary Life Member Award will be presented to recognize a member of the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists for outstanding contributions to the profession and/or the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists, beyond the normal call of professional or voluntary obligations.

An Honorary Life Member Award may be granted in recognition of:

- i) Outstanding contribution to the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists;
 - ii) And/or a distinguished record of service to the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists;
 - iii) And/or specific achievements that enhanced the profession;
 - iv) And/or long term service to the profession with a distinguished record;
 - v) And/or a distinguished record of professional service to the community.
1. The nominee must have made a special contribution to the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists either on a local, provincial or national level.
 2. The nominee(s) must be a member(s) in good standing of the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists.
 3. Nomination papers must be accompanied by a summary of the qualifications of the nominee consistent with the Terms of Reference.
 4. Nominations must be received in the office of the Registrar by January 31st.
 5. The selection will be approved by Council (SCP) following recommendation from the Awards and Honours Committee.
 6. When possible, the Honorary Life Member award will be presented in conjunction with the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists Annual General Meeting.
 7. Recipients will receive a suitably framed certificate signed by the President and the Registrar.
 8. Practising Honorary Life Members shall have their annual personal membership and practising fees waived.

9. Practising Honorary Life Members shall be responsible for all other conditions of licensure.
10. Practising Honorary Life Members shall have voting and all other privileges of practising members.
11. Non-practising, Associate or Retired members shall have their annual membership fees waived.
12. An Honorary Life Member Award does not necessarily have to be presented in any given year.

HONORARY MEMBER

An Honorary Member Award will be presented to recognize any person for outstanding contribution to the profession and/or the College beyond the normal call of professional or voluntary obligations.

An Honorary Membership may be granted in recognition of:

- i) An outstanding single contribution to the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists;
 - ii) And/or a distinguished record of service to the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists;
 - iii) And/or a single specific achievement that enhanced the profession;
 - iv) And/or through long term service to the profession with a distinguished record;
 - v) And/or has distinguished record of professional service to the community.
1. Any person may be nominated for the Honorary Member Award.
 2. Nominations must be in the office by the designated deadline.
 3. Nomination papers must be accompanied by a summary of the qualifications of the nominee.
 4. Selection will be approved by the Council of the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists.
 5. The nominee must have made a special contribution either on a local, provincial or national level.
 6. An Honorary member may not be recognized as a pharmacist, or practise as a pharmacist, unless in compliance with *The Pharmacy Act, 1996*, and its Bylaws.
 7. Honorary members may not nominate, nor be nominated to Council, nor vote in elections or general meetings.
 8. There will be no fees for Honorary members.
 9. When possible, the Honorary Member Award will be presented in conjunction with the Annual General Meeting of the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists.
 10. Recipients will receive a certificate signed by the President and Registrar.

11. An Honorary Member Award does not necessarily have to be presented in any given year.

PRESIDENTIAL CITATION

The Presidential Citation may be presented to recognize an SCP member who has made special contributions to pharmacy, but who does not qualify for any other SCP Awards. Recipients would be presented with an appropriate framed citation signed by the President and the Registrar.

1. Nominations must be received in the office of the Registrar by January 31st.
2. The selection will be approved by Council (SCP) following recommendation from the Awards and Honours Committee.
3. When possible, the Presidential Citation will be presented in conjunction with the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists Annual General Meeting.
4. The Presidential Citation does not necessarily have to be presented in any given year.

CENTENNIAL PHARMACY AWARD

The Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists introduced this award in 2011 (SCP's Centennial year) to recognize the great accomplishments of operating as a pharmacy for 100 or more years.

1. The pharmacy must be currently in operation.
2. The pharmacy must be able to prove their operating roots back 100 years or more. SCP will accept nominations of any pharmacy that has celebrated their Centennia before 2011.
3. The pharmacy may have multiple owners over the years.
4. The physical location of the pharmacy may change but the function of the pharmacy must have remained consistently the same throughout the 100 years or more of operation.
5. A biography about the pharmacy must be submitted. In this bio the pharmacy is asked to provide SCP with:
 - a brief history of the ownership of the pharmacy, including any changes of location and/or owners; and
 - an outline of community outreach and involvement.; and/or
 - any other pharmacy history
6. Each pharmacy who can provide the above will receive a certificate of recognition from the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists.
7. The Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists Centennial Pharmacy Award does not necessarily have to be presented each year.
