**SCP Registration & Membership Requirements**  
**Saskatchewan BSP Graduates of 2011**

---

After being conferred the BSP degree on June 1, 2011, graduates become **eligible** to apply for registration as a pharmacist with the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists (SCP), the regulatory authority for pharmacists and pharmacies in Saskatchewan. In order to practise pharmacy in Saskatchewan, a candidate must register as a Practising or Conditional Practising member with the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists (SCP).

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- Registration Application Form
- Membership Application Form
- Fee for Registration
- Fee for Practising Membership
- Form 1–Certificate of Acceptable Malpractice Insurance (see Bylaws – Malpractice Insurance)
- Declaration of Canadian Status form
- Data for Canadian Institute for Health Information (CIHI) form

- For **Conditional Practising** membership/registration, the items above are required.

- To complete the requirements for **Practising** membership, the following additional information is required:

- **Proof of \*Successful Completion of PEBC Qualifying Examinations / PEBC Certification**

**Example:** Copy of the letter or PEBC website confirmation indicating successful completion, along with a copy of a receipt with your PEBC ID# (for the purpose of cross-referencing the PEBC web-page proof with your PEBC ID#s).

**\*Note:** Malpractice insurance must be purchased separately; it is not included with the SCP Registration & Membership. One insurance option is through membership with the **Pharmacists’ Association of Saskatchewan (PAS) – Phone: 306-359-7277.**
