 - Portfolio review (criterion to be established in advance - may include records of direct patient care hours, patient work-ups, research activities, continuing education specific to the specialty, lectures given)

1. NISPC diabetes disease state management exam

Advanced Pharmacotherapy Management

1. Formal training (post baccalaureate in pharmacy) training from an accredited Canadian or an accredited American university (PharmD, clinical residency, clinical master, clinical PhD)
2. BCPS (Board Certified Pharmacotherapy Specialist)
3. Performance-based assessments
 - Portfolio review (criterion to be established in advance - may include records of direct patient care hours, patient work-ups, research activities, continuing education specific to the specialty, lectures given)
